Hundreds of people heard the Gospel message this past summer because over 210 teens gave up the comforts of their home to go spread the Good News overseas. 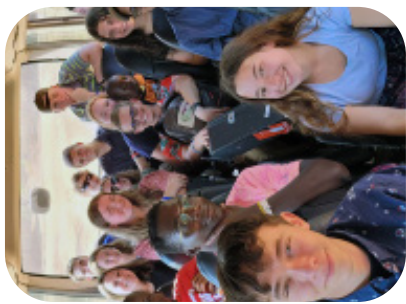

Zambia Hunger Crisis: A Call for Action
