Since moving to the USA, one of the biggest differences Emily and I have experienced is working with Teen Missions staff from all over the world. While in Malawi the work was exclusively with Malawians. Now the ministry we are part of is with people from over 18 countries! During the Christmas and New Year holidays, numerous Teen Missions country leaders organized impactful youth discipleship camps. I have been working with these leaders to help them get everything ready for the camps, from sourcing supplies and finances to promotion and schedule planning. God made a way for over 1,200 youth and leaders to be involved in these camps! This is just the beginning. Many of these youth and leaders will also join the Teen Missions Bible schools around the world. This spring I will help Teen Missions leaders in the Philippines, Zambia and other countries within the 10/40 window to run youth discipleship programs. This summer Emily and I will be taking a group of 20 teens to Germany to work alongside the partners I made there. In addition to serving with our Ukrainian friends, we will also partner with another ministry that serves people from different countries living in Germany. We will be involved in a Ukrainian youth camp like I was

last year. Our team will do evangelistic activities in Germany as we partner with others who serve Christ in this beautiful country! Emily and I are looking for financial support for our family to accomplish this.

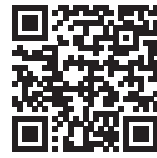

Ministry Update

The Tough Gator 5K Mud Run is an “event with a purpose!”



100% of the proceeds from our annual fundraiser in 2023 were sent to our TMI ministries overseas. The proceeds assisted families and orphans with school fees, uniforms, food, and other daily needs. It was also used in unexpected ways. This is a story from our Malawi country coordinator, Miscious.



“Greetings in Jesus name. When I visited the Wellman Family Rescue Unit, I found this poor Agogo (grandmother) sitting down. I felt sorry. She does not have anyone to help her. Her house is just by the entrance of our ministries, and she struggles with the rain daily. She did not beg anything from us, but when I saw this, I discussed what we can do to help her.” Miscious and the Malawi staff had some bricks to start helping build a house but didn’t have cement or other materials needed. Miscious was able to use

\$300 from the Mud Run money they had received to build a new house for her. Miscious says that the Agogo appreciates the house and said, “Teen Missions has given her a new life and she has seen the love of God.” The chief of the local village said that, “It is a real gesture that Teen Missions is here to show the love of Christ.”
